Below are some examples of acceptable and non-acceptable locations for fences meeting the house. According to the by-laws:

"No fencing shall be located forward of the rear plane of the dwelling unit."

Diagram #1 is strictly according to the rule but #2 is allowed in order to give a some variation. For homes with an obstruction, diagrams #3 and #4 show allowable placement of the post. Diagram #5 is not an acceptable location for the starting fence post.

Any other location is on a case-by-case basis and is at the discretion of the Architectural Review Committee
